



COGCC CDP Pre-Hearing Application Process and Timeline*

Sept. 29, 2017	Crestone submitted the first “conceptual and preliminary” draft of Comprehensive Drilling Plan (CDP)
Oct. 2 - 13, 2017	COGCC reviewed first draft preliminary CDP
Oct. 13, 2017	First draft preliminary CDP posted to COGCC website (cogcc.state.co.us)
Oct. 16 - Nov. 3, 2017	Crestone holds two surface owner meetings and commits to meet with agencies with regulatory responsibility related to the CDP (Boulder County, Town of Erie, CDPHE, CPW, etc.)
Nov. 17, 2017	Crestone submits second draft preliminary CDP, incorporating any feedback from stakeholders
Nov. 20 - 22, 2017	COGCC reviews second draft preliminary CDP
Nov. 27, 2017	Second draft preliminary CDP is posted to the COGCC website
Nov. 27 - Dec. 8, 2017	First opportunity for written public comment on second draft preliminary CDP through the COGCC website
Dec. 18, 2017	Crestone submits all conceptual, preliminary and final CDP plan elements (Final CDP), posted to COGCC website
Dec. 18, 2017 - Jan. 19, 2018	Second opportunity for written public comment on Final CDP; COGCC Director evaluates Final CDP and stakeholder input
Jan. 26, 2018	Opportunity for COGCC Director to file a hearing application requesting COGCC acceptance of Final CDP
March 19 - 20, 2018	Commission hearing on Final CDP (if COGCC Director has filed application)
