# The Hub

## FACT SHEET

Crestone utilizes a centralized production facility, known as the Hub, in an effort to reduce the impact of its operations on nearby communities and maximize efficiencies. The Hub, located just east of Erie, Colorado in Weld County, serves as a single location for collection and processing equipment and reduces the typical wellpad size and Crestone's overall footprint.

### Utilizing the Hub

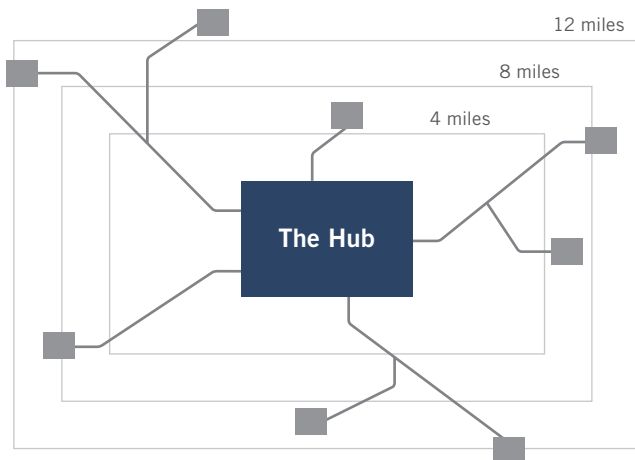
The Hub hosts a liquids processing area to further separate water from oil, stabilize oil, and capture the rich vapor. It allows Crestone to reduce a typical wellpad size by about 70 percent\*, from approximately 5 acres down to 1.5 acres\*.

\*These numbers can vary depending on the number of wells per pad.

### Less is More

A single Hub is usually around 15-20 acres in size, and is designed to support a multi-pad development approach.

It is often several miles from drilling sites and residential areas, resulting in 92,000 miles of in-town oil truck traffic being replaced by approximately 35 miles of 12-inch pipe.

Crestone also taps into nearby water sources, virtually eliminating in-town water hauling truck traffic.

Each of these factors greatly reduce the overall amount of dust and noise associated with truck traffic.
